C G/D GM7/D

C D7/C
So the only thing to feels sad about is

Bm7 Bbdim7
All the dogs and the horses you'll have to outlive

Am7 Am (add9) G →

Good - bye....

C D7/C
But as the curtains close and the last prayers are said

Bm7 Bbdim7
All my dogs and my horses appear round my bed

Am7 Adim7 Gm →
They have come to say one last good - bye

G (sus4-3s and sus#5-5 in wind parts)
